Resolution No.1 :

The ICT committee discussed the letter No. CJM(N)/1587 dated 29th June,2020 submitted by Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nagaon and resolved that one All in one computer with minimum specification of 8GB RAM/1TB HDD/i3 processor and one Duplex Laser Printer preferably make:Canon/HP may be procured depending on the availability of funds by following the codal formalities of procurement.

Resolution No.2 :

The Systems Officer informed the committee that as per direction of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court testing of E-filing module is successfully done in Nagaon district Court with a dummy database and except the fee payment module all the other modules


of E-filing application are working properly. The Systems Officer also informed that before implementation of E-filing module in live environment the entry of master data in CIS of Advocate details is necessary. After a detail discussion the committee resolved that a form with fields like Name, Address, Enrollment No., Mobile No, e-mail ID etc. may be circulated among the advocates by uploading it in the official websites of Nagaon District Judiciary for collection of the details of Ld Advocates of Nagaon so that the advocate master database can be prepared in CIS.

With the above resolution, ICT committee meeting is concluded with vote of thanks to and from chair.


